### Funding Award for Torrance Street Trail Extension

**Maryville, MO** – The City of Maryville has been selected by the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) to receive federal funds in the amount of \$143,259.84 through the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for the Torrance Street Trail Extension Project. The proposed project will construct over 1,600 linear feet in eight (8) foot wide concrete sidewalk along Torrance Street from Walnut Street to Munn Avenue. Extension of the trail along Torrance Street completes a strategic connection and access to six (6) previous trail projects funded since 2008. The proposed location currently has no sidewalks and will be designed off-street to allow for safe separation of pedestrians and vehicular traffic while providing full ADA accessibility. Federal funds will account for 64% of the project and the local match was included in the FY'19 Budget. A public meeting will be scheduled for local residents during the preliminary design process to allow for further input on the project.
